Role Description

- Role title:** Technical Advisory Panel member
- Number of positions:** Expected to be five but will be based on the number and quality of applications
- Remuneration:** Voluntary (agreed expenses to be paid by the Trust)
- Primary purpose:** To provide technical expertise on the assessment of grant applications for projects taking place in the Great Victoria Desert (WA). The Great Victoria Desert Biodiversity Trust will open a grants round in June 2015. The focus of the grants round will be research and on-ground activities related to the conservation of Sandhill Dunnarts and Malleefowl.
- Role expectations:** Panel members will be expected to review and rate applications based on determined criteria. Panel members will also be expected to attend two meetings, either in-person or via tele-conference, to discuss and finalise the most suitable applications. The Chair of the Technical Advisory Panel will report outcomes to the Management Panel of the Trust for final approval (see reporting structure below).
